This activity can be related to "It's Your Story, Tell It!". Take the opportunity to learn what a quilt really is and how to create one. Learn how quilts were used in the past and how they have impacted the generations before us. Each child will take home a mini 4"x4" quilt.

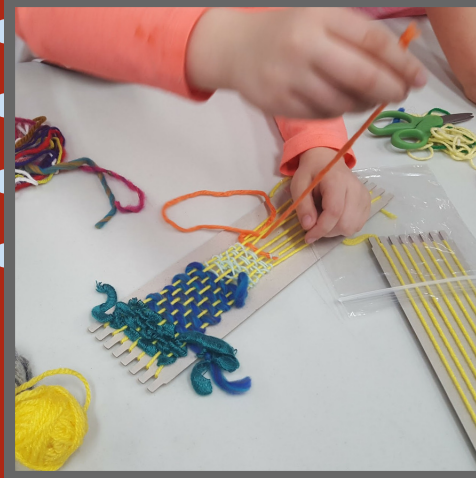
Weaving for Beginners

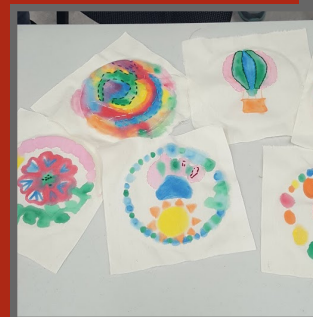
Turning Everyday Objects into Jewelry
