Festival City Symphony and Music Director Carter Simmons will present “From Many, One,” featuring the music of great American composers. Regarded as the Dean of African American composers, William Grant Still wrote his *Fourth Symphony* to evoke the sense of nobility present in all Americans, and to celebrate the best in our country’s people. The performance will begin with festive music from George W. Chadwick’s *Symphonic Sketches* and conclude with a reflection of America’s can-do spirit, Aaron Copland’s rousing *Rodeo Suite*.

- Meet the Musicians presentation (1:30pm on stage) featuring instrument demonstrations by orchestra members
- Children’s Program Notes (pre-concert on stage) with discussion of the afternoon’s music selections
