There is nothing like activity and fresh air to make a girl HUNGRY! Camp meals and snacks are healthy and kid-friendly. Most meals are prepared by our cooks and are eaten in the dining hall. Three and five night campers: you will also cook at least one meal yourself outdoors.

Some of the foods we eat at camp are: French toast sticks, eggs, walking tacos, mac and cheese, grilled cheese and tomato soup, and pizza pudgie pies. Plus there's always plenty of fruit, veggies and dip, and salad!



Sweet Dreams

At Camp Evelyn, you will sleep on cots covered with mosquito netting in tents set up on raised platforms or in cabins. Blankets, pillows, sleeping bags, sheets from home, and maybe even a favorite stuffed animal will make your cot comfy and cozy. Counselors sleep in tents or cabins that are VERY close by, but not in the same tent or cabin as you. Decisions on what unit you'll call home for your time at camp will depend on how many girls are at camp that week, your age, the camp session, and the availability of our units. At Camp Manitou, you will sleep in troop houses on mattresses, slumber-party style.





Kapers are chores. It is important in Girl Scouting to learn that everyone must do their share. In small groups, you will take turns doing kapers like setting and clearing dining hall tables, sweeping, raising and lowering the flag, keeping your tent or cabin mess-free, and helping camp be as beautiful as it can be.

PARENT INFORMATION

Hey parents! These next few pages are for you. Get all the information you need to understand the importance of summer camp, feel comfortable sending your daughter to camp, learn how to register, and more!

Safety

Safety is priority number one at camp. Our counselors complete intense training on how to keep girls safe while still having lots of fun. Camp Evelyn and Camp Manitou are operated by the standards of Girl Scouts of the USA, which meet or exceed the standards of the local and state health departments.

All counselors pass a thorough screening process including criminal and sexual offender background checks. All counselors are certified in CPR and first aid, and many are lifeguards. A qualified health supervisor is on-site at all times, and a doctor is on call. Our camps are a safe place, and you can rest comfortably knowing your daughter is being well taken care of.

We don't let a little rain stop us – and sometimes it's even fun to play in the rain – but some program activities are dependent upon the weather. In the event that there is severe weather in the area, all girls are moved to our storm location on camp property.

Cell Phones & Keeping in Touch

Camp is purposefully a place where girls can be "unplugged," allowing them to fully connect with each other and the environment. Cell phones and other electronic devices are not allowed at camp.

A letter or email from home can make the difference between a good day and a great day! Mail a letter to your daughter before her camp session and have her pack pre-addressed envelopes and stamps so she can write back! There are also CampGrams available on CampDoc. This is a one-way communication tool that lets you send messages to your daughter while she is at camp. We post photos daily to the Camp Evelyn Facebook page and our photo program, Waldo Photos, so that you can follow along with all the fun your daughter is having at camp. More information about CampGrams and Waldo Photos will be provided after you register for camp.

Special Needs

EVERY GIRL deserves the chance to camp. Our camps can accommodate most physical, medical, developmental, dietary, behavioral, or communication needs. Contact the Director of Camp and Program to discuss the nature of your daughter's specific needs and any concerns or questions you might have.

Camp Store (Canteen)

The Camp Evelyn store (Canteen) is bursting with camp goodies including T-shirts, stickers, water bottles, toys, additional activity items, snacks, and more. A popular item, the yearly camp T-shirt will cost \$30. All Camp Evelyn campers will have the opportunity to visit the Canteen at least once during their session, including Camp Evelyn day campers. See below for a sneak peek of some items that will be in the Canteen this summer!



Help your daughter bring her camp memories home by depositing funds into her camp store account when you register for camp, anytime before camp, or during check-in. Cash, check, credit card, and program credits earned in the cookie sale are accepted in the canteen. Any remaining balance at the end of the camp session can be donated to camp or will be refunded to you following the camp session.

Let your daughter know you will be thinking of her with a camp care package! Care packages are purchased when you register and are given to your daughter on her first day at camp. This year's care package costs \$40 and contains: a cotton backpack, plush key chain, water bottle, bandanna, sunglasses, postcards, and a camp bracelet.

Help your daughter prepare for camp!

After you've signed your daughter up for camp, there are a few things you can do to help her (and yourself) get ready for her time at camp. Here are a few of our favorite tips and ideas:

- Talk about camp together. The more both of you talk about camp, the more comfortable you will be when it's time for her camp session. See what questions she has, what she may be nervous about, and what she's looking forward to most.
- Help her pack for camp but don't just do it for her. Life at camp will be much easier

if she knows what she has and where to find it. It'll be great practice for when she's packing to come home at the end of camp.

- Explore camp ahead of time. Attend our spring camp events (see page 16). Virtual tours are available on our website. Seeing camp with your own eyes will help you both feel more comfortable with camp.
- Send her off with a smile! Your attitude about summer camp has a huge influence over her experience. If you are excited for her and have nothing but positive things to say, chances are she will feel the same way.

Why camp?

Summer is when some of the most fun childhood memories are made, but it's also an awesome opportunity for your daughter to grow, learn, and become her best self. Here are seven amazing benefits your daughter will get from her overnight summer camp experience:

- 1. She'll make new friends. There's nothing quite like giggling over games in the tent or cabin or singing with new besties around a campfire. That's why it's actually good to send her to camp where she might not know many (or any) other girls! Having a diverse group of friends, not just kids she knows from school, will broaden her horizons and help her see her own worth, too.
- 2. She'll see all she can be. In an all-girl environment like camp, girls are more comfortable trying new outdoor activities, and they get to take the lead every single time meaning there's plenty of room at the top for your daughter to take charge and flex her muscle, both when it comes to outdoor adventure and crucial leadership skills that will last her a lifetime.
- 3. She'll turn off her phone and tune in to nature. Getting out in nature, soaking up the sun, or dashing inside during a sudden downpour is way more exciting than any app she might have on her phone and is all part of the adventure of camp. Unplugging for a while will keep her more present and truly enjoying every moment instead of simply watching it from a screen.
- 4. She'll grow her grit. The truth is, she might scrape a knee or elbow while she's away and that's a good thing! When she learns to get back up after minor setbacks, like scrapes and bumps, she's building resilience and learning that she's a lot tougher than she thinks.
- 5. She'll meet new mentors. Having a variety of awesome role models will help your girl see the many ways to be successful and happy in life. And the incredibly supportive staff and counselors at camp are ready to step up to the plate and inspire!
- 6. She'll gain independence. Being away from home especially if that's a new thing for her! – might be a bit intimidating to both your daughter and you. If your daughter isn't a Girl Scout yet, you will add the \$30 Girl Scout membership dues to the camp fee during the registration process so that your daughter will become a member. For an incredible deal, pay \$63 to be a member for a whole additional year.

After registering for a session, refunds less a processing fee are considered on a case-by-case basis with three weeks' notice or due to an emergency.
