In particular, personal attacks, inappropriate language, spamming, and excessive posting will not be tolerated. Girl Scouts of Manitou Council reserves the right to remove posts advertising commercial products, as well as those that violate a social media platforms terms of service, or are inaccurate or otherwise objectionable.

Posts about individuals, other companies, non-for-profits, and products are not equal to endorsements. Comments and views are expressed during live streams are not equal to endorsements.

Girl Scouts is a non-partisan non-political organization.

Be Kind and Courteous. We're all in this together to create a welcoming environment. Let's treat everyone with respect and live by the Girl Scout Promise and Law. Healthy debates are natural, but kindness is required.

Keep it Girl Scout focused. Conversations should be Girl Scout-centered. Debating, insulting, or similar conversations regarding other youth activities may be removed.

No Hate Speech or Bullying. Make sur everyone feels safe. Bullying of any kind isn't allowed, and degrading comments about things like race, religion, culture, sexual orientation, gender, or identity will not be tolerated.

No Promotions or Spam. Give more than you take to this group. Self-promotion, spam, or irrelevant links aren't allowed. These posts will be removed.

Girl Scouts of Manitou Council's Additonal Troop Takeover Guidelines

When participating in a Troop Takeover, you are representing Girl Scouts of Manitou Council. All girls appearing in photos, videos, and stories should be properly dressed and have NO questionable quotes or pictures on their clothing. Girl Scout gear/uniforms are always appreciated.

Do not share full names. If name tags are being worn, make sure no last names are visible. Share only your Troop Number and first names, when applicable.

Only share and feature council approved activities. Safety activity checkpoints will always be followed.
